



Guidelines for Abstract Preparation

The authors should adhere to the abstract format given below. Failure to follow these guidelines may result in the rejection of your abstract by the Editorial Board of the 6th International Research Conference (TrinCo 2024).

Abstracts should only be from original research. Reviews, Concepts and future studies are not accepted.

Formatting guidelines:

Academic Track of the Abstract – Should be on the top right-hand corner of the abstract (Font: Cambria ,10, Right Aligned, *Italic*).

Title of the Abstract: (Font: Cambria, 14, Bold, Centered). The title should be brief, descriptive, and should not span more than 2 lines. Capital letters should be used only for the first letter in the first word of the title, scientific names, and proper nouns. Abbreviations should not be used.

Authors and Affiliations: The names and affiliations should appear below the title. Type authors' names, giving each author's initials before the last name and the superscript number to indicate affiliations (see the template given below). Leave no space between the authors' names and the affiliations. When there are more than two or more authors and if they are from different institutions their affiliations should be identified by superscript Arabic numbers (see the template). Identify the corresponding author by an asterisk (*). The e-mail address and mobile number of the corresponding author should be indicated left aligned below the keywords (Font: Cambria, 10, Centered).

Text/Body of the Abstract: A concise and factual abstract is required. An abstract is a single paragraph, without subheadings, indentation, or references. It should be an explicit summary of your presentation that states the research problem, the objectives, the methods used, and the major results and conclusions. Do not include bullets/lists or references in the abstract. (Font: Cambria, 12) The use of non-standard or uncommon abbreviations and references should be avoided. Keywords should be given leaving a one-line space below this text. (Font: Cambria, 12, Justified)

Keywords: Three to five keywords or phrases in alphabetical order, separated by commas.

References, tables, or figures should not be included in the abstract.

Language: Use United States (US) English. However, both US and UK English should not be written in a single article.

Software: Microsoft Word - the template has been provided at the end of these guidelines and can be downloaded from the <http://trincoconf.tc.esn.ac.lk/submission/>



Page setting format (Layout):

Paper size: A4 (210 x 297 mm) typed single-sided only.

Font: Cambria

Line spacing: 1.0

Text alignment: Justify

Margins: 2.5 cm (1") on all sides

Word count: Maximum of 300 words

Accepted abstracts will be published online in the Conference Proceedings.

Academic Track of the Abstract – Should be on the top right-hand corner of the abstract. (Font: Cambria, 10, Right Aligned, Italic)

Title of your abstract, capitalize first letter - (Font: Cambria, 14, Bold, Centered, Line Space 1.5)

Names of the Authors – First Author¹, Second Author² and Third Author^{1,2,*} (Last name after that author's initials, Font: Cambria, 12, Centered, Bold, Line Space 1.5)

Affiliations - ¹Department, Faculty, University, Institute or School, Country (Font: Cambria, 12, Centered, Line Space 1.5)

Abstract

Body/Text of the abstract: 250-300 words, no subheadings (Font: Cambria, 12, justified)

Keywords: (3-5 keywords, arranged alphabetically, separated by commas, Font: Cambria, 12, Left Aligned)
